The Pacific Partnership is pleased to offer the newly created Children's Art Show to be held during the Pacific Heritage Festival and Art Fair on September 17, 2016, located at the Pacific Station Plaza. This event has been created to encourage and recognize artistic talents of our children, ages 5 to 18. The show will be open during the entire day, from 9 AM to 8 PM, and all artists will receive a ribbon for exhibiting.

Participants: The Children's Art Show is open to all school age children in grades K through 12. This is a local art show for residents living within the Meramec Valley R-III school district geographical area.

Prizes: Prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will be awarded to 4 groups: Ages 5-7, 8-10, 11-13, and 14-18.

Permission Form with No Entry Fee: Each participant must complete and submit a "Children's Art Show Application and Permission Form." There is no fee to participate.

Children's Art Show Format: Only one original piece of flat (2 dimensional) artwork per person may be submitted. The media options are pencil, markers, charcoal, chalk, water color, and/or acrylics. The size cannot exceed 11 x 17 inches. The artist's name, age, parent's (guardian's) name(s), telephone number, and address must be provided and clearly readable **on the reverse side of the art piece.**

- a. Composition – Elements of Art b. Craftsmanship – Process, Media c. Creativity
